Requirements

- Applicant must have a high school diploma or GED.
- Student must complete 32 hours of the Bachelor of Christian Counseling course work.
- Student must submit an official transcript of all academic work at their previous school, college, or university.
- Student must submit one letter of recommendation (letter may be from his or her pastor, previous professor, or supervisor). Letter must be in a sealed unopened envelope.
- Resume'
- Personal statement (100 words or more) describing reasons for wanting to study in the area of Christian Counseling along with confession of faith.
- Life/Ministry Experience credit of 3 or more years will be accepted. Credits earned through prior life experience can count for the maximum of 75% of an undergraduate degree program. The Life Experience can count for a maximum of 50% of the graduate program (Masters only). No Life Experience credit can be given at the doctoral level.

Requirements

- The Master of Christian Counseling Degree requires 30 credit hours beyond the Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Ministry, Bachelor of Divinity, or its equivalent.
- Student must have a bachelor's degree (any field) or Bachelor of Ministry or Biblical Studies Degree.
- Applicant must submit a transcript that shows all courses taken beyond high school along with grades earned.
- Life/Ministry Experience credit of 3 or more years will be accepted. Credits earned through prior life experience can count for the maximum of 75% of an undergraduate degree program. The Life Experience can count for a maximum of 50% of the graduate program (Masters only). No Life Experience credit can be given at the doctoral level.
- Student must submit 2 letters of recommendation. One letter must come from the applicant's pastor and one from the applicant's previous professor. Letters must be in a sealed unopened envelope.
- Resume'
- Personal statement (150 words or more) describing reasons for wanting to study in the area of Christian Counseling along with confession of faith.

Doctor of Christian Counseling Degree

A Doctoral Degree in Christian Counseling is one of the highest-level of degree you can earn in the ministry area of Christian Counseling. The Doctor of Christian Counseling Degree program is only open to those who have been actively engaged in some form of professional ministry for at least three years. This Degree program is intended or designed for those who are seeking to practice Christian counseling in the areas of pastoral ministry, church ministry, and crisis and grief, Chaplaincy, etc. This degree is offered to credentialed ministry professionals and is not designed for those just entering the field of counseling. More than ever more Christian Counseling influential leaders are needed. Once you have completed this program you will be positioned as an authority within these settings: church, community, mission field, and or biblical counseling center.

Requirements

- The Doctor of Christian Counseling degree requires 70 hours of graduate study in Bible, Christian Ministry, or Theology beyond the Master of Arts, Master of Divinity, or its equivalent.
- The student must have a master's degree in Christian counseling, psychology, theology, or its equivalent.
- Student must have a minimum GPA of 3.2.
- Applicant must submit 3 letters of recommendations for the Doctorate Degree in Christian Counseling. (A letter of recommendation should come from the applicant's pastor, previous or current professor, or current employer, and a letter from another source of the applicant's choosing.) Letters must be in a sealed unopened envelope.
- Personal statement (250 words or more) describing reasons for wanting to study in the area of Christian Counseling along with confession of faith.
- Resume' (if student has not previously submitted his/her resume to TTS Theological Seminary)
- Official transcripts of all academic work taken beyond graduation of high school.
- A final official transcript indicating that Master of Arts degree or its equivalent has been granted.
- The Doctor of Christian Counseling requires 72 hours of coursework beyond the Master of Arts, Master of Divinity, or equivalent. This program requires 6 hours of study cases inclusive of the dissertation or project thesis.

The Bachelor of Theology degree prepares the student for teaching, pastoring, and preaching as a minister in Christ's Church as well as the agenda God called the individual student to. This program is designed for students who want a thorough knowledge of the Bible (including the biblical languages), theology, and practical ministry training. This Degree will encourage the student to understand and study the Bible all while being a servant to God and will position the student to thrive in their ministry and lead in their community.

Requirements

- The Bachelor of Theology requires 35 credit hours with 12 hours being theology classes along with 6 hours of correspondence classes.
- Official transcript of all academic courses taken beyond high school.
- Life/Ministry Experience credit of 3 or more years will be accepted. Credits earned through prior life experience can count for the maximum of 75% of an undergraduate degree program. The Life Experience can count for a maximum of 50% of the graduate program (Masters only). No Life Experience credit can be given at the doctoral level.
- Resume'
- 2 (Two) letters of recommendation (one from the student's pastor and one from the student's choosing). Letters must be in a sealed unopened envelope.
- Personal statement (120 words or more) describing reasons for wanting to study along with confession of faith.

- Personal statement (170 words or more) describing reasons for wanting to study along with confession of faith.
- Official transcript of all academic work taken beyond high school and previous degree granted.
- Life/Ministry Experience credit of 3 or more years will be accepted. Credits earned through prior life experience can count for the maximum of 75% of an undergraduate degree program. The Life Experience can count for a maximum of 50% of the graduate program (Masters only). No Life Experience credit can be given at the doctoral level.
- Student must submit 2 letters of recommendations (letter must be from his/her pastor, previous or current professor). Letters must be in a sealed unopened envelope. (This is only if student has not submitted 2 or more letters of recommendations previously for TTS Theological Seminary)

Doctor of Theology

The Doctor of Theology is an advanced degree program that is designed to enhance and provide practical hands-on and professional skills with the ability for leadership and ministry positions. The women and men who enrolls in this program of study must show they are capable of doing doctoral work and have an earned master's degree from TTS or an acceptable college or seminary with a composite of at least 175 credit hours.

Requirements

- The student must complete a minimum of 60-90 semester credit hours, which includes a 60,000-word Thesis in the field of theology.
- An official transcript of previous educational studies beyond high school from a theological seminary, college, or university.
- Applicant must submit 3 (three) letters of recommendations from the student's pastor, previous professor, and from another source of the student's choosing. Letters must be in a sealed unopened envelope.
- The student must submit a personal statement (230 words or more) of his or her desire to pursue a doctoral degree in theology.
- Resume' (if student has not previously submitted his/her resume to TTS Theological Seminary)
- A final transcript indicating that Master of Arts degree or its equivalent has been granted.
